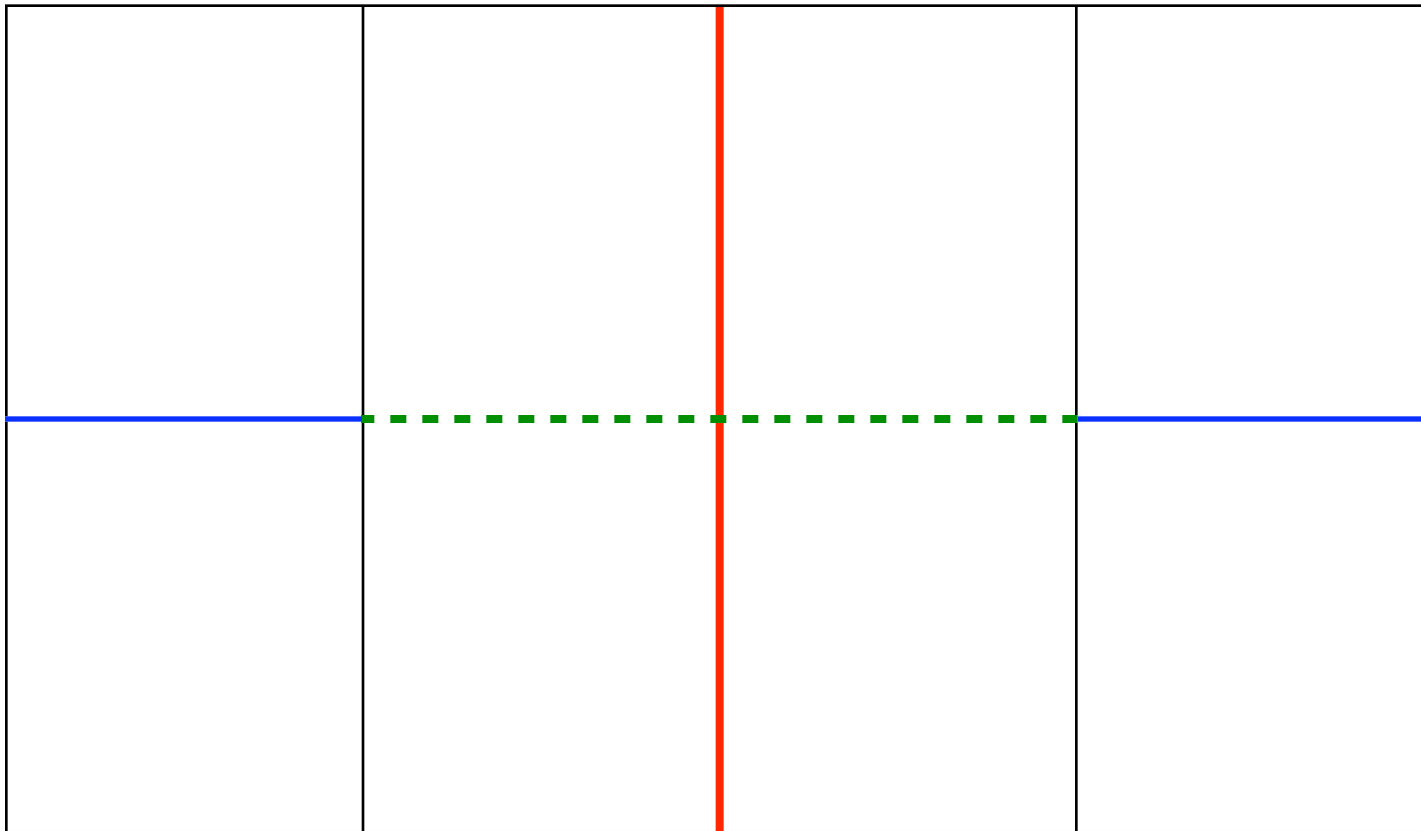


# No Staple Book

This is a great writing tool for students. I make them and keep them in a basket at my writing station for students to publish their stories on. Intermediate students could make their own, as it is very simple to do. I have found that the children love these and are extremely motivated to write in them. Many students like to make series books out of them, and put them in our Author's Box for other students to read. This is just a template - try it with A4 or standard copy paper.

1. Fold along all lines first.
2. Open and fold in half along the red line to cut through the green dotted line.
3. Open and fold along the blue line, and push to the cut section opens like a mouth. Keep pushing and fold in half.
4. Don't despair - it does work but it takes some time to get the hang of it. Once you do, it is so easy!



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
